RESOLUTION of the District of Powers Lake

Counties of Kenosha & Walworth, WI

WHEREAS, the District of Powers Lake was formed on February 19, 1985 by the adoption of Resolution No.168 by the Kenosha County Board of Supervisors; and

WHEREAS, the District of Powers Lake Board of Commissioners consists of 5 elected and 2 appointed commissioners as provided for in the By-Laws of the District and in the statutes of the State of Wisconsin; and

WHEREAS, Kenosha County has appointed Ms. Judy Jooss to the District of Powers Lake Board of Commissioners on October 6, 1998; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Judy Jooss has served as a Director of the Wisconsin Association of Lakes (WAL) for a period of 14 years from May 1994 to April 2008. For 13 of those years she was an officer of the organization serving on the Executive Committee as secretary, treasurer, chairman of the board, vice-president and president; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Judy Jooss has helped the University of Wisconsin Lakes Program develop a training course for lake district commissioners which she now co-presents as a full day workshop at the annual state lake convention; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Judy Jooss has served as one of the citizen representatives on the Kenosha County Land & Water Conservation Committee March 17, 1998; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Judy Jooss has served on the planning committees for the annual Wisconsin Lake Convention and the Southeastern Wisconsin Lake Workshop for the past 10 years; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Judy Jooss served on the Wisconsin DNR Boating Safety Advisory Committee from 2001 to 2008; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Judy Jooss helped create two citizen advisory committees to the Twin Lakes Protection & Rehabilitation District in 1989 and served as chairperson of the Grant Planning (later Planning & Protection) Committee from 1990 until 2003; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Judy Jooss has served with distinction as a commissioner of the District of Powers Lake and through her comprehensive knowledge of the natural environment and lake management has contributed to the mission of the District; and through her unique technical and practical knowledge has contributed to the organization and administration of the District.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the District of Powers Lake considers Ms, Judy Jooss to be an invaluable resource and hereby requests that Ms. Judy Jooss be retained as the Kenosha County appointed representative to the Board of Commissioners of the District of Powers Lake
